



Children's Activity Host (2 Positions) Purple Woods Maple Syrup Festival March 9 to April 8, 2018

SUMMARY

This is a seasonal position, required to work before and during the Purple Woods Maple Syrup Festival from February to April (Festival dates are March 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 24, 25, April 7 and April 8) (closed for Easter from Friday March 30th to Sunday April 1st). **A mandatory half-day training and orientation session is planned for Saturday March 3, 2018.**

The Children's Activity Host is responsible for working at the Children's Activity Areas at Central Lake Ontario Conservation's annual Purple Woods Maple Syrup Festival. Children's Activity Hosts are responsible for engaging children and adults in a variety of hands-on craft and game activities in both an indoor and outdoor environment. This includes providing verbal instructions and demonstrating pioneer and indigenous games using props supplied. You will also be required to assist with the daily set-up and cleanup, contribute to general housekeeping duties and promote the Central Lake Ontario Conservation as a lead agency in watershed protection and stewardship.

Children's Activity Hosts will be provided with instructions and scripts as part of the half-day training and orientation session. They will also be required to complete a mandatory online health and safety and personnel training session. This position requires the individual to stand and work half a day indoors and a half-day outdoors. The indoor environment offers heat from an external source. Children's Activity Hosts will be responsible for supervision of volunteers at their activity to ensure compliance with CLOCA policies.

Children's Activity Hosts report to the Education Instructor. The Festival's hours of operation are 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. The employee is expected to report for work at 9:00 a.m. and will work no later than 3:00 p.m.
